A mental health recovery center is back up and running in Atascadero.

The Peers Empowering Peers, or PEP, Center, located at the 5385 El Camino Real, reopened its doors Wednesday afternoon.

It recently underwent a make-over to better serve the community.

More than 400 people attend support groups, education classes, employments clubs and other programs at the center.
