The Emergency Shelter Clinician offers individualized therapy, case management and referrals for homeless people with mental health and/or drug and alcohol addiction problems. Services are provided by TMHA in cooperation with Good Samaritan Services, County of Santa Barbara Alcohol Drug and Mental Health Services and other local agencies.

#### What Services Are Provided?

- Brief assessment
- Vocational counseling
- Case management
- Referrals
- Individual and family therapy

The program is located in an 80 bed emergency shelter with on-site detoxification services, a Department of Public Health physician's assistant, a Department of Social Services worker and a public health nurse.

#### Who is Eligible for the Program?

All Emergency Homeless Shelter residents

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
