The Community Housing and Residential Case Management Program offers long-term, affordable housing in a stable and supportive environment for adult residents of San Luis Obispo County who are experiencing mental health difficulties. Residents are helped to gain skills needed to make choices that reflect their own values, preferences and goals.

Where Are the Houses?

Our houses are located in community neighborhoods.

Will I Have Roommates?

Yes. Residents share the household and yard-work chores, attend weekly house meetings and support each other in efforts toward health maintenance and community integration.

What Services Are Provided?

Residential Case Management Services and activities are provided in residents' homes and in the community. Staff meets with residents on a regularly scheduled and as-needed basis. Services are adjusted to meet each resident's individual needs—intensive, moderate or little or no levels of support.

Staff provide assistance with independent living, information and referral services, advocacy and consultation services, counseling and intervention services, and training and education.

Who Is Eligible for Community Housing?

Residents are referred by County Behavioral Health Services, which provides ongoing treatment and medication monitoring.

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
